

## WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

HospiScript recognizes the importance of protecting the privacy of information we may receive from visitors to our websites. You may visit our website without telling us anything about yourself, and our website does not currently employ any technology that would collect any domain or other information from your browser or computer. If you contact us and choose to provide personally identifiable information, we will utilize it to respond to your inquiry. We do not collect or maintain personally identifiable information for resale purposes or share your information with any other company or organization. Any and all uses comply with applicable laws.

In some cases, HospiScript's use of your information will also be subject to requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act ("HIPAA"). This will be the case when you submit information to HospiScript as your pharmacy (e.g., to refill a prescription), in which case the terms of HospiScript's HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices will apply.

### Children

You should be aware that our website is not intended for, or designed to attract, children under the age of 13. As noted above, we do not collect personally identifiable information -- including an individual's age.

### Personally Identifiable Information

HospiScript collects personally identifiable information, such as names, addresses, e-mail addresses and the like, only when voluntarily provided by a website visitor via e-mail. We will notify you as to the uses, if any, we intend to make of that information beyond responding to your inquiry. If you send a resume in response to a job opening posted on our website, we will retain your personal information only for the purpose of filling the job opening and will not use it for any other purpose.

### Unsecured Email Warning

Please note that any information you send to HospiScript via email is sent via an unsecured email link. Due to the nature of the Internet, there is a possibility that unsecured (unencrypted) email could be intercepted and read by third parties. HospiScript assumes no responsibility for interception of confidential information you send in an unsecured (unencrypted) email message.

### Links to Other Sites

As a resource to our visitors, we may from time to time provide links to other websites. The policies and procedures we describe here do not apply to third party sites – only to the HospiScript site. We suggest checking the privacy policies on each linked site directly for information on their privacy, security, data collection and distribution policies.

## **Cookies**

A cookie is a piece of data stored on your computer that allows HospiScript to remember that it has previously communicated with your browser. HospiScript uses both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. For the session ID cookie, once a user closes his or her browser, the cookie simply terminates. A persistent cookie is a small text file stored on your hard drive for an extended period of time. Once a persistent cookie is saved on a user's computer, only HospiScript can read it and no other website. Persistent cookies can be removed by following Internet browser help file directions. Like most standard website servers, HospiScript uses log files to collect non-personally identifiable information. This information includes Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp and number of clicks.

## **Other Uses of Personal Information**

We will disclose your personal information if, in good faith, we believe we are required by law to do so, including but not limited to disclosure to law enforcement or other government officials in connection with an investigation of fraud, intellectual property infringement, or other activity that is illegal or may expose us to legal liability. We may also disclose your information in the event of a merger, acquisition, reorganization, bankruptcy, or other similar event. If this occurs, your personally identifiable information may be transferred to our successor or assign, or may be sold as an asset of our company. This does not apply to information we hold on behalf of your health plan which, as stated above, may be used and disclosed only for those purposes permitted by your health plan's Notice of Privacy Practices.

## **Security**
